ECM served as the project manager for El Paso International Airport's (EPIA) complicated renovation and expansion program of their passenger terminal. An important goal of the team was to minimize both the interference with the 24 hour-per-day airport operations and the impact to the retail business within the facility.

The 350,000 square foot airport terminal was completely remodeled including the replacement or upgrade of all interior finishes, mechanical, electrical and life safety systems, adding restroom facilities and a new interior arrival/departure signage system. The facility required extensive demolition and asbestos abatement as well as complete update of the FAA mandated access control systems.

Behind the scenes, a new fire sprinkler system was installed and the baggage handling facility was replaced and expanded to provide two new conveyor systems.
