\$8 Million 20,300 SF As part of the 2018 GO Bond Program, the Animal Services Center of Mesilla Valley is a new facility adjacent to the existing Animal Service Center.

The 20,300 SF Animal Services Center project is expected to meet the operational needs of the ASCMV in working to achieve the center's "no-kill" philosophy and in updating and enhancing its facility needs. The main building includes a new surgical suite, administrative office space, required accessory functional areas, and housing for up to 250 cats while an additional four buildings can house up to 600 dogs. Coordination was required with the programming, design, and construction of the proposed, separate dog park behind the facility.

ECM has worked closely with the design team and the Animal Services Center staff to make sure all requirements were met. ECM's services for the city included budget planning and management, coordination of the survey, analysis of existing facilities, and the coordination of A/E selection and management from detailed programming through the release of construction documents, and proposal and contract management.
