

### **COST/SIZE**

\$12.9 Million 90,000 SF The Coliseum is a 90,000 SF multi-use facility for numerous recreational sporting activities and community events. The 6,100-seat venue is home to SHSU's volleyball team, and men's and women's basketball teams.

The renovation was conducted on an expedited schedule while coordinating with ongoing operations. Originally completed in 1976 and undergone only minor renovations, the facility needed significant mechanical and functional upgrades as well as an aesthetic face-lift to attract a broader spectrum of events to the facility, improve recruiting capabilities for the men's and women's athletic teams, and to extend the useful life of the coliseum.

ECM's role on this project was to provide project management, consultation, and leadership in support of the University's Facilities Planning and Construction staff in their day-to-day operations as well as act as a trusted advisor to Facilities Management and University Administration.
