One of the \$35.6 million GO Bond projects is the master planning, design, and construction of a new park, the East Mesa Public Recreation Complex.

LOCATION

Las Cruces, NM

The new facility will be located on a 350-acre parcel of land belonging to the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) and leased by the City of Las Cruces. The complex will be located on twenty-five acres and will feature parking lots, a baseball complex, eight pickleball courts, soccer and football fields, and multi-use fields. The park will also include a concessions area and multiple playgrounds.

ROLE

Project and Construction Management

ECM assisted city staff in A/E selection. After the selection, ECM has worked closely with the design team and Parks & Recreation personnel to coordinate public input meetings, design charrettes, and data analysis to meet the specific needs of this park's initial service area and future needs as a regional park. Phase 1 of this project is scheduled to be completed by the end of the third quarter of 2022.
