The Fire Station No. 3 replacement project was included as part of the Program Management Contract for the 2018 GO \$35.6 Bond Program

The Las Cruces Fire Station No. 3 replaced the existing 50-year old fire station built in 1967. The new station can house up to 10 firefighters at a time, provide space for three large fire trucks, including a ladder truck, and has an outdoor training courtyard, a fitness room, and a training tower. One critical feature of the new fire station is the high-speed doors with a spiral opening mechanism allowing the door to open between 5 to 7 seconds. The fire station provides fire protection and emergency medical services to the West Las Cruces District.

To ensure the Fire Department Staff received a fire station that met their needs and the bond goals, ECM conducted three design scope review meetings with the Fire Marshal, Deputy Fire Marshal, and the firefighters assigned to Fire Station 3. The design team provided sketches – at first – to have a basis for discussion, which allowed ECM to procure amenities lists from the Fire Department personnel. Through this discussion for amenities inclusion in the design, ECM kept track of estimated costs to control the budget.
