\$15.1 Million 32,000 SF The General's Market Dining Hall is a next-generation building created with an open and transparent design housing three indoor primary dining areas: Tailgate Alley, The Bearcat Kafe, and The Post Oak Kafe, creating a combined seating capacity of 600. The facility also features a covered outside seating area with fans and decorative lighting to keep outdoor diners comfortable year-round. The design scheme mimics other campus buildings such as the Old Main Market and the Student Health Center with a consistent aesthetic look and feel.
