The program consisted of 11 projects including upgrades to University streets, parking lots, water, wastewater, electrical, storm sewer, chilled water, and hot water distribution systems.

This was a challenging program involving numerous A/E firms and stakeholders. Special care was taken to assure timely execution and compliance with the rules and regulations of multiple utilities and agencies including the City of Huntsville, Texas Commission on Environmental Quality. Entergy Electric and CenterPoint Gas.

As a Program Manager, ECM's services included the coordination of the design consultants, the contractors, the SHSU staff and administration, and other key stakeholders. Significant tools used for this effort included master scheduling, logistics planning and utilities shut-down coordination, weekly meetings with all participants, and clear reporting to SHSU.
