The City of El Paso contracted ECM to provide construction management services for the improvements to the Stanton and Paso Del Norte Bridges, funded with ARRA funds. Upgrades included the installation of toll equipment, security cameras, domestic and fiber-optic connections, and state-of-the-art automatic public restrooms in the plaza areas.

The Paso Del Norte improvements include the construction of a new 1540 SF toll booth building, the Lion's Placita park revitalization, and the installation of 9,840 SF of new bridge pedestrian canopies and a new secured parking area. The Stanton Bridge improvements included a new bridge toll administration building of approximately 10,900 SF, a new landscaped plaza, a 100-foot long mural wall, and 4,400 SF of new bridge pedestrian canopies

ECM provided inspection services, constructability reviews, traffic coordination and scheduling, and nightly construction activities. ECM also held weekly meetings, reviewed pay applications, change orders, performed schedule and progress reviews, managed quality control testing, and reported progress reports.
