The Joey Barraza and Vino Memorial Park included the construction of a fenced in dedicated dog park separated into two sections for small and large dogs, the addition of three regulation size soccer fields, a new all-abilities playground area with shade canopies and safety surfaces. Also included was new site lighting, a packed gravel walking path, site landscape, expanded irrigation system, site furnishings, and expanded parking. The existing park was named to honor the service of Border Patrol Agent, Joey Barraza, and his K-9 partner Vino who were lost in the line of duty.

ECM provided construction management services to the City of El Paso throughout the project. These services included attending weekly OAC Project Team meetings, providing on-site quality control support, conducting daily site walks to observe site conditions, ensure safety policy enforcement, monitoring work in progress activities and completed work for compliance. The Resident Project Representative met daily with the project superintendent to discuss current and upcoming work operations, potential roadblocks, and work arounds.
