The Camino Real Regional Mobility Authority (CRRMA) is the agency that develops and manages the overall transportation plan for various local government entities in the El Paso region. ECM has been a key member of the General Engineering Consultant (GEC) project team providing construction inspection and reporting services to ensure compliance with TxDOT specifications guidelines and requirements.

The Mission Ridge Blvd. Drainage and Roadway Improvement project was designed to accommodate increased traffic from residential and commercial growth in the area. The project consisted of the construction of widened roadways, flex base, HMA, concrete curb and gutter, embankment, excavation, drainage structures, retention pond with rock wall, retaining wall, irrigation system, landscaping, roadway illumination, sidewalks, traffic signal, signing and striping, as well as the addition of a 24-inch water main.

ECM provided on-site field inspections, daily reporting, traffic control, work compliance, and a field representative to work directly with the teams.
