\$8 Million 30,370 SF The Northwest Campus Addition project is one of six projects in El Paso Community College's (EPCC) 2016 Master Plan Bond Program.

The project included the addition of a new, state-of-the-art 30,000 SF Classroom/Laboratory Building. The new building houses an administration area, lecture hall, computer labs, wet labs, information technology classroom area, and highly desirable student study space. The construction of the additional space eliminates the current enrollment limit due to space restrictions, allowing EPCC to meet the high demand for a trained workforce in these innovative programs.

EPCC wanted to continue with the design "personality" of this Campus and thus asked the architect to enhance the design within the parameters set by earlier buildings within the Campus. This collaboration produced an iconic curved structure set on a sloping site worthy of a design award.
