El Paso International Airport (EPIA) constantly updates and upgrades its facilities and relies on ECM International to make these changes happen.

This project involved the replacement of all 15 extendable passenger boarding bridges (sometimes called jet bridges or jetways) in the airport. As Construction Manager, ECM was responsible for all aspects of the work including the complex coordination required between the FAA, airport officials, contractors, and equipment manufacturers.

EPIA approached ECM and their team when they faced a complicated renovation and expansion program of their passenger terminal. An important goal was to minimize interference with the 24-hour-per-day airport operations and to minimize the impact on the retail business within the facility.

EPIA and ECM have a long-term relationship with projects ranging from runway reconstruction to terminal renovation to the new CONRAC facility.
