When the City of El Paso began the renovation campaign for the downtown area they turned to ECM to manage the restoration of the "jewel" of the community.

The Department of Interior regulations are strict in order to maintain the special designation. To ensure progress, meetings were held with the various governmental entities concerning their special requirements and reporting procedures. As a result, all grants requested were successfully awarded.
