The William R. Powell Student Health and Counseling Center is a 28,500-square-foot facility. The facility combined and expanded the existing Student Health Center and the existing Student Counseling Center into a new two-story facility that provides physical and mental health services via 17 exam rooms, 3 triage rooms, 19 counseling rooms, pharmacy, lab, and dental office, and doctors, nurses and administrator offices. In addition, there is a 74-seat divisible conference room with a full array of technology that is used for staff development and wellness education.

ECM's role at SHSU has been to provide consultation and leadership for capital projects at the appropriate times to assist in delivering the university's mission to provide high-quality education, scholarship, and service to qualified students for the benefit of regional, state, national, and international constituencies. We augment the university's Facilities Planning and Construction staff in their day-to-day operations as well as act as a sounding board to the Facilities Management and University Administration, all while providing compliance guidance with the policies and procedures of the Texas State University System.
