Considering the airport's role as a gateway to the city and a major economic driver, the EPIA project was part of the city's strategic plan to increase its curb appeal and maintain continuous improvements.

The project consisted of major improvements to the EPIA terminal hardscape and landscape, significant site improvements, roadway improvements, and landscape and lighting improvements. Elements included the installation of new shade and ornamental trees, shrubs, groundcover, and blooming plants, an automatic irrigation system, the incorporation of color changing, and programmable LED lighting across the grounds and the Terminal building.
