\$1.6 Million 6,000 SF CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocates) is a national volunteer organization supporting abused and neglected children.

ECM assisted CASA in the implementation of design, construction, and initial occupancy of the \$1.6M Training Facility and Support Center. The new facility is a 6,000 sq. ft. office building which will house approximately 15 CASA staff members and include a 48-seat training room. This facility provided a location to train the court appointed volunteer child advocates that work to improve the lives of foster children for the next 20-30 years. ECM was honored to participate and donate a significant portion of its effort.

Working in conjunction with the Board and staff, ECM developed a master budget, schedule, and an implementation strategy. ECM prepared all procurement documents, worked with CASA attorney, and assisted in the selection of designer and builder teams. ECM also led the procurement of all owner-required services such as Geotech, survey, environmental, and worked with TxDOT and the City of San Marcos.
