#### **College of Osteopathic Medicine**

The College of Osteopathic Medicine at Sam Houston State University in Conroe is the newest osteopathic college in Texas. Complete with advanced medical facilities and cutting-edge technology, the college will offer labs and learning space for clinical anatomy, molecular and cellular biology, and physiology and pharmacology.



#### **Piney Woods Residential Hall**

Piney Woods Hall is a 700-bed, 233,000 SF residence hall and learning center. The facility features single and double-occupancy rooms, community lounges, a faculty-in-residence apartment, laundry and recreation areas, multi-purpose rooms, community kitchens and study rooms. The ground floor contains an outdoor courtyard and community learning center both designed for students to connect, congregate and collaborate.



#### **Health Science Center**

ECM managed the third-floor addition and reconfiguration of the Texas Tech Health Sciences Center Clinic in El Paso, Texas. The project included ophthalmologist labs, a pediatric clinic, classrooms, and administrative offices. The existing building, which contained orthopaedic, internal medicine, OB/GYN, and UBCC clinics also received significant modifications.



### **Cardwell Collaborative Biomedical Building**

This privately-owned biomedical research and technology building is located at the Medical Center of the Americas in central El Paso, Texas. The three-story, 60,000-sf facility was designed for collaboration of private start-up companies and university personnel. It features 20,000 sq. ft. of biomedical incubator space (including wet and dry laboratories, offices and meeting spaces).



### Career and Technical Education Building and Garage

The Career and Technical Building is a seven-story building that includes 160,212 SF of parking, 375 parking spaces, and 65,000 SF of classroom and lab space. The campus exists within a unique context, adjacent to historic districts within a downtown urban setting. It is also the home to many unique educational offerings, with a focus on healthcare and allied fields.
