The El Paso Police Department Parking Improvements consist of a two-phase project at the El Paso Police Headquarters.

Phase I improvements include demolition of existing concrete, handrails, asphalt, lights with concrete bases, concrete columns, electrical services, and chain-link fence. The construction aspect includes re-grading and asphalt paving of the 40,000 square-foot adjacent parking lot, including installation of lighting, landscaping, security fence, and security entrance gate.

Phase II involves the demolition of the existing two-story 60,000 square-foot concrete parking structure, backfill to street level, concrete piers, asphalt paving, parking stripping, lights with a concrete base, rockwall, electrical services, and the installation of security cameras. The work required traffic control and erosion control measures such as hay bales, silt fence, and stabilized construction entrance and exit.

ECM provided full-time, onsite construction management and coordinated with the local police as the demolition took place directly next to the station.
